



Looking for a short-term housing solution? You could be eligible for up to \$350 rent allowance a month paid directly to your landlord until March 2013.

Are you eligible?

Yes you are eligible if you and the rest of your household are on Housing Connections' waiting list application for subsidized housing with eligible status **and**,

You are working and:

- your household employment income is below an income limit;
- you are paying more than 40 percent of your household income on rent;
- you don't owe money to a social housing provider in Ontario; and,
- you agree to move to a pre-approved unit in the housing allowance program.

OR

You receive Ontario Works:

And you are a single-parent family who pays more than 25 percent of the maximum Shelter Allowance on rent and meet at least **one** of the following categories:

- have reported income from earnings;
- have employment related expenses;
- children are all over twelve;
- are participating in Learning, Earning and Parenting (LEAP).

Interested?

Fill out a housing allowance application and submit it by the deadline.

You must be approved by the landlord and move to the unit.

We will only contact eligible applicants with the earliest application date. You will not be contacted if you do not fit the eligibility criteria, or if your application date is not early enough for you to be offered a unit.

This is not a rent-geared-to-income program and does not affect, in any way, your application for subsidized housing or your position on the Housing Connections' waiting list for rent-geared-to-income housing.
